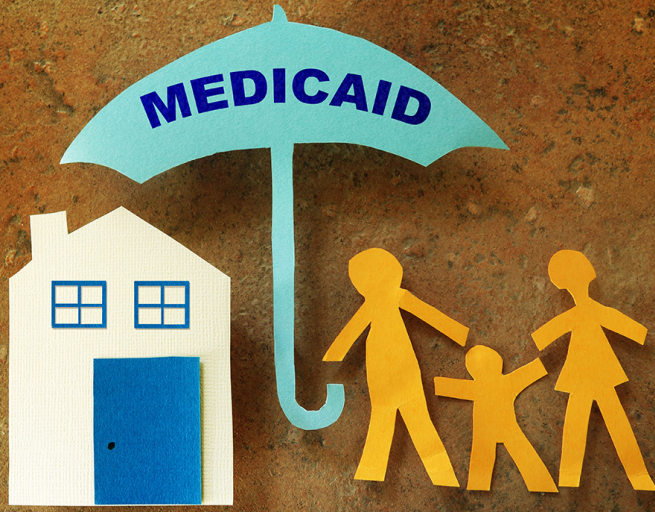

The Changing World of Medicaid: Updates & Developments

The past two years have seen important developments in Medicaid programming across the United States. Expanded Medicaid eligibility and special provisions have been instrumental in our nation's efforts to address the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency and its effects on individuals, families, and communities. Dr. Plein is a Professor of Public Administration and Eberly Family Professor for Outstanding Public Service at West Virginia University. His academic research on health and social policy has been published in such journals as *Health Affairs*, the *Journal of Health and Human Services Administration*, and *The Journal of Health Care for the Poor and Uninsured*. His expertise on Medicaid and health policy has led to invited presentations at the state and national level, presentations to the West Virginia Legislature, and interviews with state and national media. Dr. Plein is also part of the Military Families Learning Network's Military Caregiving concentration.

CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDIT
