While personal savings such as an emergency fund can reduce the financial costs of some challenging life events, transfer of risk to insurance is also a critical component of economic security for military families. - **Homeowner's Insurance**, which provides financial protection for the home's structure, the personal belongings inside in the case of loss or theft, and personal liability coverage.
- **Renter's Insurance**, which provides financial protection for personal property within the rented home in the case of theft or damage and personal liability coverage.
- **Auto Insurance**, which provides financial protection in the event of an auto accident, damage to a vehicle, or theft.
- **Umbrella Policies**, which provide extra liability insurance beyond the limits of homeowner's and auto insurance.
