

Chat GPT is like a very smart robot friend who can talk to you using words, just like you and I are talking now! It can answer your questions and have a conversation with you, just like a real person. This makes it really good at understanding language and coming up with its own answers to your questions.


#### **GPT Acronym Description**

- G = Generative: It creates (generates) brand new content (not plagiarism)
- P = Pre-trained: It is a LLM (large language model) trained on a massive data set of text information
- T = Transformer: Uses advanced processing techniques to plan sentences and produce an original final product

- Downside: It Makes Mistakes!
- Hallucinations: Term used to describe authoritatively sounding statements that are flat out WRONG







## Blueprint for AI Bill of Rights

You should be protected from unsafe or ineffective systems.

You should not face discrimination by algorithms and systems should be used and designed in an equitable way.

You should be protected from abusive data practices via built-in protections and you should have agency over how data about you is used.

You should know that an automated system is being used and understand how and why it contributes to outcomes that impact you.

You should be able to opt out, where appropriate, and have access to a person who can quickly consider and remedy problems you encounter.


