Disability related vocabulary	 Key Points: Define the disability Define key terms related to the disability Discussion Questions: Have you ever heard of? What do you know about?
Equipment-related story content	 <i>Key Points:</i> All people use tools and materials that help them complete certain tasks Define and show various examples of the type of equipment used in the story <i>Discussion Questions:</i> What kind of tools does the character use? How do you think that tool helps the character? What kinds of tools and materials do you use that help you?
